# Key Features

- Any device, any time, any where (no java requirement)
- Self-service password resets
- No lockouts (inactivity timeout exists)
- Mobile friendly
- Intuitive navigation (3-4 clicks)
- Gradebook
- Communication – email, portal (student & family)



# More Key Features

- Customizable reports (csv, excel, pdf, charts)
- Thousands of fields
- Filters, grouping, sorting
- Alerts (medical, SPED, legal)
- Distributed Learning functionality

# Portals (Student & Family)

- View course schedule, attendance, marks
- Communicate with teacher (email)
- Portfolio
- No training focus until after go-live
- Not a clerical function

# Implementation Schedule

- February 2015 – Implementation Plan Developed
- March – June 2015 – Training Sessions – All Stakeholders
- July & August – BCeSIS to MyEducationBC Conversion
- August 24 – September 3, 2015 – Refresher Training Sessions
- August 24, 2015 – All SD71 Schools Go Live
- September 2015 – Field support provided (mentors & IT Team)
- Ongoing – constant training on new features
- NOTE: PVP will lead the implementation at your school!

# Training

- “Train the Trainer” model
- April 7-9 initial training session
- PVPs will lead training at their sites
- Focus group training (PVP, Clerical, SPED, Teachers, etc)
- Refresher training in August
- Ongoing training – support the product throughout its lifecycle
  - Just in time training for additional functionality as it’s introduced

# What can we do now?

- Standardize data in BCeSIS – simplifies conversion
  - Postal codes, phone numbers
  - Contact details, custody, legal
  - Medical alerts, etc...
- SDTRAIN access will be setup very soon – live product with scrambled data (not production data)
  - This environment will be used for all training prior to go-live.



# Business Process Changes

- All teachers (elementary & secondary) to take attendance, not clerical
- Teacher/Student/Parent communication – via portal
- IEP
- Elementary Assessments
- Secondary Gradebook
